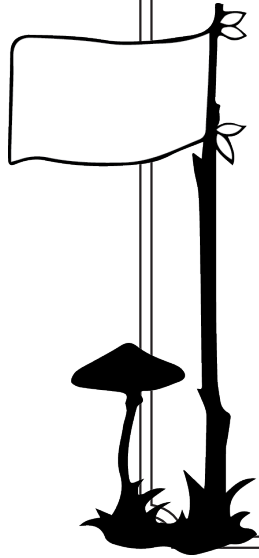

Skin contact

Here are your white wines - that are made like red wines! Expect a little grip, some savouriness and much fuller fruit profiles than white wines. Although skin contacted wines are commonly thought of as a new concept - the Italians in the far northern reaches have been making wines like this for hundreds of years! These funky and unusual wines give them the ability to pair with food that whites don't usually work with - try betel leaf bliss bombs or the grilled Thai sausage.

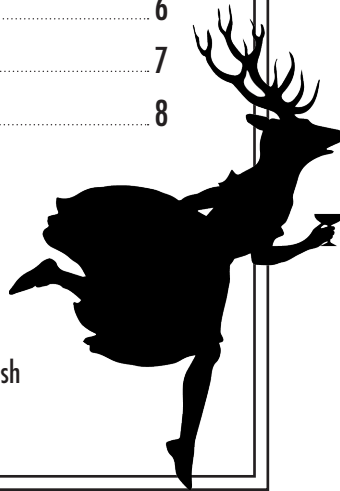

Pash Rash \$24

We have to admit, this is one of our most popular cocktails! Do you like Vodka? Do you like passionfruit? After something not too sweet? I'll stop you there ... you need a Pash Rash.

Snow White \$24

This stunner is almost as delightful as the hospitality of seven dwarfs. Tanqueray Gin, peach, elderflower, lemon juice and bitters concoct such a powerful spell one just won't be enough.

El Spanko Margarita \$24

A perfect fusion of Mexican and Thai to tantalize your tastebuds. 1800 Coconut Tequila, toasted coconut syrup, coriander and lime, rimmed with a toasted coconut salt.

Bend The Knee \$24

A beautiful blend of fruity and floral liqueurs. Blood orange, muscat grape, violet and honey, shaken with lemon juice and orange bitters to create a cocktail that feels like it dances on your palate. Aromatic and nostalgic.

Bartenders Handshake \$25

At the base of this dark and sultry cocktail is a nip of Jameson Irish Whiskey, stirred down with Punt e Mes, Grand Marnier, Angostura bitters and of course Fernet-Branca. The Bartenders Handshake combines bitter and sweet in the most delectable of ways ... though this drink is not for the faint hearted!

Takanaga \$24

Tanqueray Gin, yuzu and cherry blossom meld in true Japanese fashion; delicate and light, yet flavourful and refreshing. A Gin Sour style cocktail with a modern twist.



Shaken & served 'Up'

Gin Gimlet \$23

A historical drink of practical origins. Tanqueray Gin with house-made lime cordial and fresh lime juice traditionally kept the scurvy at bay on the Naval Ships of the 17th and 18th Century. This could be the reason why sailors were known as 'Limeys' back then!

Corpse Reviver #2 \$23

A pre-1900's cocktail said to 'revive the corpse' the morning after. A sophisticated union of Tanqueray Gin, Lillet Blanc, Cointreau and fresh lemon juice with a few devilish drops of Absinthe. Be warned, however, after four attempts at reviving, the corpse turns undead.

Classic Daiquiri \$24

Clover Club \$24

From a pre-prohibition Philadelphia men's club. This classic blend of Tanqueray Gin and house-made raspberry syrup, served 'Sour Style' is said to have been drunk by the distinguished gentlemen worthy of rubbing shoulders with the fathers of industry.

Charlie Chaplin \$23

This simple concoction was one of the premier drinks in the famous Waldorf-Astoria Hotel in Manhattan. Haymans Sloe Gin, Apricot Brandy and lime juice fuse into a fun sherbert style sipper. The perfect pre OR post show tippie.

Aviation \$24

From the Hotel Wallick in New York, circa 1916. Tanqueray Gin, Creme de Violet, Luxardo Maraschino and lemon meld into a dry, floral, gin-focused concoction. It is no mystery why this classic has stood the test of time.

Bramble \$25

Gin, lemon, blackcurrant and blueberry served over crushed ice - this delightful modern English classic is a great little sipper on a summery afternoon.

Step into Bermuda in the 1860s and enjoy a classic combination of Caribbean rums with spicy ginger beer, lime and Angostura bitters. According to a legend, the name Dark 'N' Stormy was coined by a sailor sometime after WWI who, whilst enjoying the cocktail, commented that it was the "colour of a cloud only a fool or a dead man would sail under".

Monaco \$23

Inspired by the flavours of the French Riviera - Cointreau, 78 Degrees Rosé Vermouth, strawberry and cranberry shaken over rocks will make you feel like you are sitting on your yacht in Monte Carlo Bay.

Boulevardier \$25

This creation is ascribed to Erskine Gywnne, an American writer who founded a monthly magazine in Paris called Boulevardier. A Negroni's older brother, perhaps - with Buffalo Trace, Sweet Vermouth and Campari served over rocks, and a fat wedge of orange.

Vieux Carré \$25

Named after the French Quarter in New Orleans around 1930, this cocktail is a complex yet very smooth sipper. Quite similar to the Sazerac, this little sister takes sweet vermouth to accompany the Cognac, Rye Whisky and bitters.

White Negroni \$25

A lighter, more herbaceous version of a Negroni. Tanqueray Gin, Suze Gentian and Lilet Blanc stirred and served on the rocks.

- Anderlecht, Belgium

Notoriously known as the Champagne of Belgium. This world renowned brewery has a cult following and it's not often you see this beer here. This Gueze is brewed with 100% organically grown wheat, malted barley and hops. It has an acidic, fruity taste with a delicate and woody fragrance, followed along with a dry finish that lingers on the palate.

Lindemans Ginger Gueuze 6% 750ml 75

- Vlezenbeek, Belgium

Lindemans developed the Botanical Lambics, a collection of old Guezeus with a twist. A blend of Lambics is fermented with fresh ginger, bringing a spicier flavour amongst all the sourness.

The amazing process of fermenting beer at cold temperatures. This method of using bottom fermented yeast is called "Saccharamoyces Uvarum" and paved the way for so many crisp and refreshing beers we know today.

Pilsner - brewed like a lager with the addition of hops for some floral and bitter notes:

Pilsner Urquel – Plzen, Czech Republic 4.4% 330ml 13

A signature Czech beer filled with flavour. Balanced sweetness from triple-decocted malts and bitterness from Sazz hops create a smooth and aromatic experience.

San Miguel – Phillipines 4.4% 330ml 12

Gold in colour with a gentle bready nose, this beer is a pleasantly crisp and malty drop that pairs quite well with the rich flavours and spice you come to expect from our kitchen.

Lager - light, crisp and easy to drink:

Two Bays Lager 'Gluten Free/Coeliac' - Mornington Peninsula, Victoria 4.5% 375ml 15

A pale, easy drinking lager that's full of citrus aroma with hints of tangerine.

Singha Lager - Bangkok, Thailand 5% 330ml 11

The Original Thai Beer. Light, clean and crisp. A perfect summer-time pairing with our food.

Weihenstephaner 1561 Kellerbier - Munich, Germany 5.6% 500ml 16

First brewed at the 500th anniversary of the purity law. This full flavoured lager uses rare single estate Hallertau hops.

Weihenstephaner Original Helles - Munich, Germany 5.1% 500ml 15

Crushable German blonde lager. The OG, brewed to tradition this lager is delicately aromatic and strong in flavour.

Aecht Schlenkerla Krausen - Bamberg, Germany 4.5% 500ml 19

Matured Helles lager combines with green Marzen Rauchbier to create lightly smoked and gentle rich malt flavours.

Ales & Pale Ales

The oldest and original. Today, ale refers to top fermented yeast that needs warmer temperatures and is faster to brew than lager yeast. Ales are usually more flavourful, full bodied and aromatic compared to lagers.

Ales - malt driven with a crisp light finish:

Duvel - Puurs, Belgium 8% 330ml 16.5
Translating as "Devil" in Flemish, this beer has a beautiful golden hue and a habit of sneaking up on you. Tastes seriously good though!

Delirium Tremens - Melle, Belgium 9% 330ml 22
A condition better know as the D.T.'s; a hallucinatory episode that may occur during withdrawal form chronic drinking. Also a strong, spicy, Belgian Ale served with pink elephants and dancing alligators.

Coopers Extra Strong Vintage Ale 2023 - Adelaide, South Australia 7.5% 355ml 20
Rare and unique. Coopers aged ale gets better the longer it's in the bottle. You will notice sherry notes and sweetness from the ageing.

Pale Ales - top fermented, predominantly made with pale malts - hops make a more floral & sometimes bitter experience:

Two Bays Pale Ale 'Gluten Free/Coeliac' - Mornington Peninsula, Victoria 4.5% 375ml 16
An easy drinking American Pale Ale. Hopped up with a subtle-yet-beautiful citrus aroma.

Sierra Nevada Pale Ale - California, USA 5.6% 355ml 15
Classic example of a pale ale. It has a deep amber colour and an exceptionally full-bodied, complex character. The fragrant bouquet and spicy flavours are the result of the generous use of the best Cascade hops.

Sierra Nevada Torpedo Extra Pale Ale - California, USA 7.2% 355ml 16
A big bold American pale ale, highlighting complex citrus, pine and the herbal character of American hops.

Indian Pale Ales (IPA)

The name IPA is often thrown around, yet the origin and the flavours of this beer have changed over the years. Gone are the days of big bitter flavours, and in with the fruit-forward hazy, juicy, fruity IPAs of today.

Two Bays IPA 'Gluten Free/Coeliac' - Mornington Peninsula, Victoria 6% 375ml 17
A classic middle of the road IPA bursting with flavour. A little bitter bite with a pine and fruity aroma.

Wheat Beers

Also known as WitBier, Weissbier, Blondes or Blanche. This section is about beer that's brewed with wheat, giving it a smooth and well rounded mouth feel.

Schofferhofer Hefeweizen - Frankfurt, Germany 5% 500ml 15
Thick and cloudy unfiltered yeasty body with flavours of banana and cloves. Best tipped or swirled to get all the sediment in the bottom.

Weihenstephaner Hefeweissbier Dunkel - Munich, Germany 5.3% 500ml 15
Fruity-fresh sweetness with hints of mature bananas are balanced with delicious flavours of roasted malt. Expect a light caramel taste on the first sip.

Dark Beers

A collection of more full bodied, complex, rich beers. If you want to step up the palate from your favourite IPA or ale, dark beers are a great place to explore.

La Sirene Praline Stout - Alphington, Melbourne 5.8% 330ml 18
A modern take on the classic style using the brewery's house yeast culture and a healthy portion of toasted cacao nibs, vanilla and hazelnut to produce a lightly soured but hearty stout.

Tripels & Trappistes

Centuries old beer full of flavour and high in alcohol.

Tripels - The epitome of 'liquid bread' A meal on its own:

Westmalle Tripel - Westmalle Abbey, Belgium 9.5% 330ml 19
Widely acknowledged as the first 'tripel' in the world. A complex beer that's rich and spicy. Notes of raisins, apples, bananas, hints of pepper and cloves fill your senses. A delight with every sip!

Trappistes - Beers brewed by Monks in Monasteries:

Chimay Blue - Baileux, Belgium 9.0% 330ml 17
The classic Chimay is dark and rich with deep fruit-forward flavours. Each bottle is vintage dated and improves with age. Originally introduced as a Christmas beer, but is perfect anytime of the year.

Chimay Red - Baileux, Belgium 7.0% 330ml 15
The lightest Ale brewed by the monks at the Notre-Dame de Scourmont Abbey. Smooth with a spiciness that is complex and enjoyable. A great food beer.

Lambic Beer & Saisons

Lambic Beer - Produced by spontaneous fermentation (exposed to wild yeast and bacteria) to create a wild and sour beverage:

Brouwerij Omer Vandfer Ghinste, Kriek Max - Bellegem, Belgium 3.5% 250ml 17
Brewed with 25% natural cherry juice. Balancing sweetness and acidity, it is the perfect bottle for the lambic lovers amongst us.

Saisons - wild yeasts are used to naturally sour the beer:

La Sirene Flor Saison - Alphington, Melbourne 6.5% 330ml 18
Brewed in large french oak vats and spontaneously fermented with the surrounding microbial environment of the Darebin Parklands to produce a naturally unique beer. Sour acidity, a touch of spice, malty saison funk and floral, tropical aromas.

Ciders & Ginger Beer

Looking for something fruity and fizzy? Look no further.

Cider

Willie Smith Bone Dry Cider - Grove, Tasmania 7.2% 355ml 15

Think the traditional English dry ciders. A nice light sweetness that finishes off very dry. It's fermented twice for that extra dryness.

Eric Bordelet 'Nouvelle Vague' Sidre - Normandy, France 6% 330ml 16

Like great wine, great cider is a reflection of the underlying terroir of the orchards. Nouvelle Vague is off-dry, thirst-quenching, 'drinking' cider. It has light effervescence and has a lovely balance of sweetness.

Napoleone Pear Cider - Yarra Valley, VIC 4.9% 330ml 12

A unique combination of fruit and cider making techniques gives this a great earthy aroma, balanced well with a slight ginger spice and a nice rounded mouth feel.

Ginger Beer

Matso's Ginger Beer - Broome, WA 3.5% 330ml 12

A refreshing hit of spicy ginger that's sure to quench your thirst. Born in the harsh sun of Western Australia you know you can trust it to cool you down on those hot summer nights.
